

Mammals of Gluepot Reserve (updated June 2016)

Scientific name	Common name	Notes with reference to Gluepot
Family Tachyglossidae	Echidnas	
<i>Tachyglossus aculeatus</i>	Short-beaked Echidna	Terrestrial; occasionally observed.
Family Dasyuridae	Dasyurids	Terrestrial, nocturnal marsupials
<i>Ningai yvonneae</i>	Southern Ningai	Usually associated with spinifex habitat; rarely observed.
<i>Sminthopsis crassicaudata</i>	Fat-tailed Dunnart	Found in a variety of habitats, single observation only.
<i>Sminthopsis murina</i>	Common Dunnart	Found in a variety of habitats; rarely observed.
Family Burramyidae	Pygmy-possums	
<i>Cercartetus concinnus</i>	Western Pygmy-possum	Nocturnal, mostly arboreal marsupial; rarely observed.
Family Macropodidae	Kangaroos	Terrestrial, diurnal & nocturnal
<i>Macropus fuliginosus</i>	Western Grey Kangaroo	Commonly observed.
<i>Macropus robustus</i>	Euro	Rarely observed.
<i>Macropus rufus</i>	Red Kangaroo	Occasionally observed.
Order Chiroptera	Bats	Nocturnal
<i>Austronomus australis</i>	White-striped Free-tailed Bat	<p>Bats may be observed & heard calling whilst in flight at night time, when they are out feeding.</p> <p>They are commonly encountered at Gluepot, especially around the 2 dams, except <i>V. regulus</i> which is less commonly encountered.</p>
<i>Mormopterus petersi</i>	Inland Free-tailed Bat	
<i>Nyctophilus corbeni</i>	Corben's Long-eared Bat	
<i>Nyctophilus geoffroyi</i>	Lesser Long-eared Bat	
<i>Chalinolobus gouldii</i>	Gould's Wattled Bat	
<i>Chalinolobus morio</i>	Chocolate Wattled Bat	
<i>Chalinolobus picatus</i>	Little Pied Bat	
<i>Scotorepens balstoni</i>	Inland Broad-nosed Bat	
<i>Vespadelus baverstocki</i>	Inland Forest Bat	
<i>Vespadelus regulus</i>	Southern Forest Bat	
Family Muridae	Rats & mice	
<i>Pseudomys bolami</i>	Bolam's Mouse	Terrestrial, nocturnal rodent; rarely observed.
Introduced Mammals	Various	
<i>Capra hircus</i>	Goat	Introduced ; a major threat to vegetation; control program in place at Gluepot; relatively low numbers currently on Gluepot; relatively commonly observed.
<i>Felis catus</i>	Cat	Introduced ; a major threat to the smaller, native fauna; number on Gluepot is uncertain; occasionally observed.
<i>Lepus europaeus</i>	European Brown Hare	Introduced ; rarely observed
<i>Mus musculus</i>	House Mouse	Introduced rodent ; commonly observed around buildings.
<i>Oryctolagus cuniculus</i>	Rabbit	Introduced ; a major threat to vegetation; control program in place at Gluepot; relatively low numbers currently on Gluepot; occasionally observed.
<i>Vulpes vulpes</i>	Fox	Introduced ; a major threat to smaller, native fauna; intensive culling program in place at Gluepot; number on Gluepot is uncertain; occasionally observed.
